SAPCC was incorporated in 1992 and is one of 15 Parent Child Centers in the state of Vermont making up the VT Parent Child Center Network. We serve southern Windsor and northern Windham counties. SAPCC is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization governed by a volunteer board of directors. We believe that healthy families are the cornerstone of the community. Our campus in North Springfield continues to grow. Today, over 35 employees help build bridges of support for more than 3000 individuals each year.

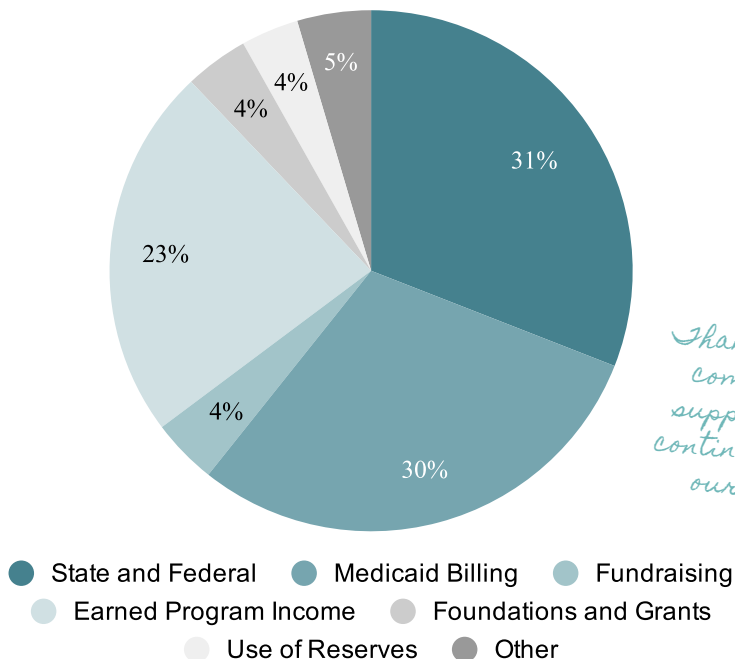

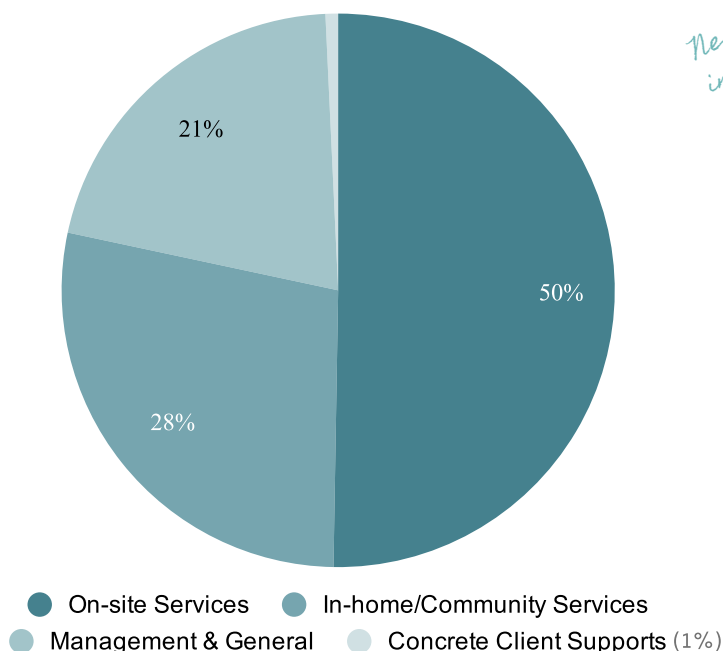
